A FRANCHISE GRANTING TO W.S.H. LOTHROP, HIS HEIRS, SUCCESORS AND ASSINGS, THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE AN ELECTRIC STREET RAILWAY IN CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF PONCE, AND BETTWEEN THE CITY OF PONCE AND THE PLAYA THEREOF.

SECTION 1.-The Executive Council of Porto Rico does hereby ordain and enact that W.S.Lothrop his heirs successors and assings, may construct and operate an electric railway together with side tracks and switches in the City of Ponce and between the said City and the Playa thereof, for a pariod of sixty tears (60) from the date of the final approval of this franchise by the Governor, over and along the following streets and highways in the said City of Ponce, and connecting with the Playa thereof.

SECTION 2.-Theroute of said railway shall be, approximately, as follows; beginig at a point on Calle Comercio in the Playa of Ponce, adjuining the lands of J.D.H.Luce, upon which it is proposed to establish certain wharves and docks, following the same streets in a wester direction, near the south side walk, passing the Custon house, to the main road or highway known as the calle Real, connenting Ponce with the Playa; thence along the said main road or highway on the west said thereof, crossing the river Portugues, to the calle Marina, thense alo calle Marina of the west said thereof in the City of Ponce to the norw corner of the Plaza de Las Delicias and continuing along the northen e side of said Plaza to the calle de la Union; thence along the west sai of the said calle de la Union to calle Victoria; thensealeng the north side of the said calle de la Victoria in an easterly direction to the northwelt corner of the Plaza del Mercado; thence continuing in an easirely direction along to the north side of said Plaza to calle de la E trely; thence in the same easterly direction along the north side of

of said calle de la Entirella to calle Mayor; thence along the east side of the said calle Mayor to calle Comercio in the said City of Ponce; thence along the east side of the said calle Comercio to calle Salud; thence along the east side of the said calle Salud to its juction with calle Marina and the main road or highway connecting Ponce with the Playa; thence returning by the route heretofore described to the starting point in the said Playa.

SECTION 3.-The right and franchise hereby ganted includes the right to occupy the public highways heretofore mentioned, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, as well as the right to condemm private property therefor, upon payment of due compensation, as - provided by law, and to erect such poles and string such wires, and do such other acts subjects to the conditions hereinafter mentioned and conformably to law, as may be necessary to establisch and maintain the service herein anthorized.

SECTION 4.-The route of said line, the plans relative theroto, and the manner of contrucction, shall be submitted to an approved by the Commissioner of the Instrior before work shall be begun, and material employed and the manner of construction shall be, at all time subject to the inspection of said Commissioner, or his authorized agents, for the purpose of securing compliance with such plans. Grantee, his heirs and assings, shall make only such changes in or modifications of the plansor work, after approval by the said Commissioner, as shall be authorized or directed by the Executive Council, through said Commissioner.

SECTION 5.-The fare to be charged shall note exeded five (5) cents for one continuouse passage, and grantee herein agrees that as soon as the wharves are completed in acordance with the concession -

granted to John D. H. Luce by the Executive Council, and a tranway shall be constructed from said warves connencting with the line mentioned in the franchise herein granted, that the said fare will include passage to and from the said warves. Grantee agrees to issue to shool children tickets at reduced rates.

Trains will be run so as to furnish during working hours a service of not more than ten (10) minutes beteen each train, and the rate for passengers and freight, as well as the conditions of service and the issue of transfer shall be regulated by the Executive Council.

SECTION 6.6. - Granty shall pay a royalty upon gross receipts as follows:

- 2% during the first year of operation.
- 3% during the second year of operation.
- 4% during the third year of operation.
- 5% during the fourth year of operation and each and everyyear thereafter as along as this franchise shall continue.
- A re-valuation of said royalties shall be made eyery ten years.

SECTIONS.-Grantee shall erct and maintain at this ownn expense a suitable bridge built upon piles across the Portuguese River for & the passage of such railway, and such bridge shall contain not less than twenty feet of clear arace so as to admit the passage of public traffic over and along the same; provided, that the public use of safed bridge shall not, in the judgment of the Commossioner of the Insterior be permited to interiors with the operation of the trains of the said railway.

SECTION 7.-Grantee shall pay all Insular and Municipal taxes which may be imposed in acordance with law.

SECTION 9.-The franchise herein granted shall be acepted within thirty (30) days after approval thereof by the President of the United States, by a writing filed with the Executive Council. Provided, that the franchise shall be presented to the President wighin thirty (30) days after approval hereof by the Governor of Porto Rico.

SECTION 10.-Work shall be begun under this franchise within sixty (60) days from the approval thereof by the President of the United States, and the entire line shall be completed and in operation within one year from such date.

SECTION 11.-A EXEMPTE cash deposit of five thousand (5,000) dollars, or approved security to the amount for the faithful fulfillment of the terms of this franchise shall be deposited by said grantee with the Treasurer of Porto Rico upon the aceptance thereof as heretofore attack. The said deposit shall be repaid or returned to grantee by the Treasurer upon a certificate from the Commissioner of the Interior that grantee has complied with the terms and condition of this franchise.

SECTION 12.-The term"grantee" as hereinbefore used shall be held to extend to and include, his heirs, seccessors and assings.

SECTION 13.- In accordance with Section 111 of the Joint Resolution of the Congress of the United States, approved kx May 1,1,900, the franchise herein granted shall be subjected to amendment, alteration or repeal; no stock or bonds shall be issued except in change for actual cash of property all a fair valuation equal in amount to the par value of the stock or bonds issued no stock or bond dividends shall be issued; the property constructed and acquired may be purchas

or taken by the public authorities at a fair and reasonable valuation and the Executive Council shall regualte the charges and conditions of service hereunder as hereinbefore specified.
